United Arab Emirates (AED) Purpose Codes

Central Bank will require purpose codes to be included in 'TAG 77B' for all currencies both Cross border / Domestic payments. Transaction processing will not be affected due to lack of 'TAG 77B' data, however the receiving bank will be required to obtain the new purpose code from the sending bank.

Inbound payment instructions to Receiving Bank in UAE without purpose codes populated in 'TAG 77B', the following actions will be taken by the Receiving Bank from 1 January 2018:

- For accounts in the books of the Receiving Bank, payments will continue to be posted; however, the Receiving Bank will be required to solicit the Purpose Code information from the Sending Bank by using "195/196".
- For accounts in the books of other UAE Banks, the payments will be propagated to UAEFTS using "CB102/CB10" with the default Purpose Code "CBP". The Receiving Bank will then be required to solicit the Purpose Code information from the Sending Bank by using "195/196".
